CERVICAL CANCER PREVENTION

WHO SHOULD SCREEN FOR CERVICAL CANCER:

- Women over 30 years at ten year intervals
- Women who experience abnormal vaginal bleeding
- Women who experience pain during sexual intercourse
- Women who have a sexually transmitted infection
- Women who are HIV positive at three year intervals

Get screened for cervical cancer free of charge in the public health facilities.
