



## CALL FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR INCLUSION IN THE NATIONAL DATABASE TO PROVIDE PAEDIATRIC AND ADULT ONCOLOGY SERVICES TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH SECTOR

The National Department of Health is developing a database of private health professionals who are prepared to provide oncology services to the public health sector. The aim of this initiative is to enhance diagnosis and treatment, of patients with cancer and reduce the backlog for oncology services.

**Competencies:** Ability to work in integrated multi-disciplinary teams across platforms. Leadership, administrative, communication and mentoring skills. Good problem-solving skills. Computer literacy.
