1 PURPOSE

- 1.1 The Ethandakukhanya Community Health Centre has remained unutilised for a prolonged period following the completion of construction works, and as a result routine grounds maintenance has not been consistently undertaken. A recent site inspection revealed extensive vegetation growth across the facility, including tall grass and weeds around buildings, vegetation growing through paving blocks, encroachment along perimeter fencing, overgrowth along retaining walls, vegetation around water infrastructure, and debris accumulation in several areas of the site.
- 1.2 The uncontrolled vegetation presents health, safety, security and maintenance risks, including the obstruction of access routes, potential fire hazards during dry seasons, concealment along perimeter fencing, possible damage to paved areas and infrastructure, and the poor presentation of a public health facility.
- 1.3 The National Department of Health therefore intends to appoint two service providers (one winner and second on standby) to undertake vegetation clearing and grounds maintenance at the facility on a routine basis, with the service provider required to attend the site once or twice per week as necessary to control vegetation and maintain the external areas in a clean and safe condition. The works will be priced on a lump sum basis for the maintenance period, with the Service Provider responsible for providing all labour, equipment, transport and disposal of vegetation removed from site.

7 INDEMNIFICATION

- 7.1 The supplier shall provide indemnification and hold harmless the NDoH (National Department of Health), its agents, and employees against any claims, damages, losses, and expenses, including attorney's fees, arising from the performance of the contracted work.
- 7.2 This indemnity encompasses all labour, materials, and equipment necessary for fulfilling the service outlined in the contract. It applies to claims, damages, losses, or expenses that meet the following criteria: 1) involve injury to or destruction of tangible property (excluding the work itself), including loss of use resulting from such damage; and 2) are caused, in whole or in part, by any negligent act or omission of the supplier, its sub-suppliers, individuals directly or indirectly employed by them, or anyone whose actions could potentially hold them liable. Regardless of whether the liability arises in part due to the actions of the indemnified party, the supplier assumes complete responsibility and liability for complying with all applicable local and state legislation and regulations concerning the supplier and its employees.

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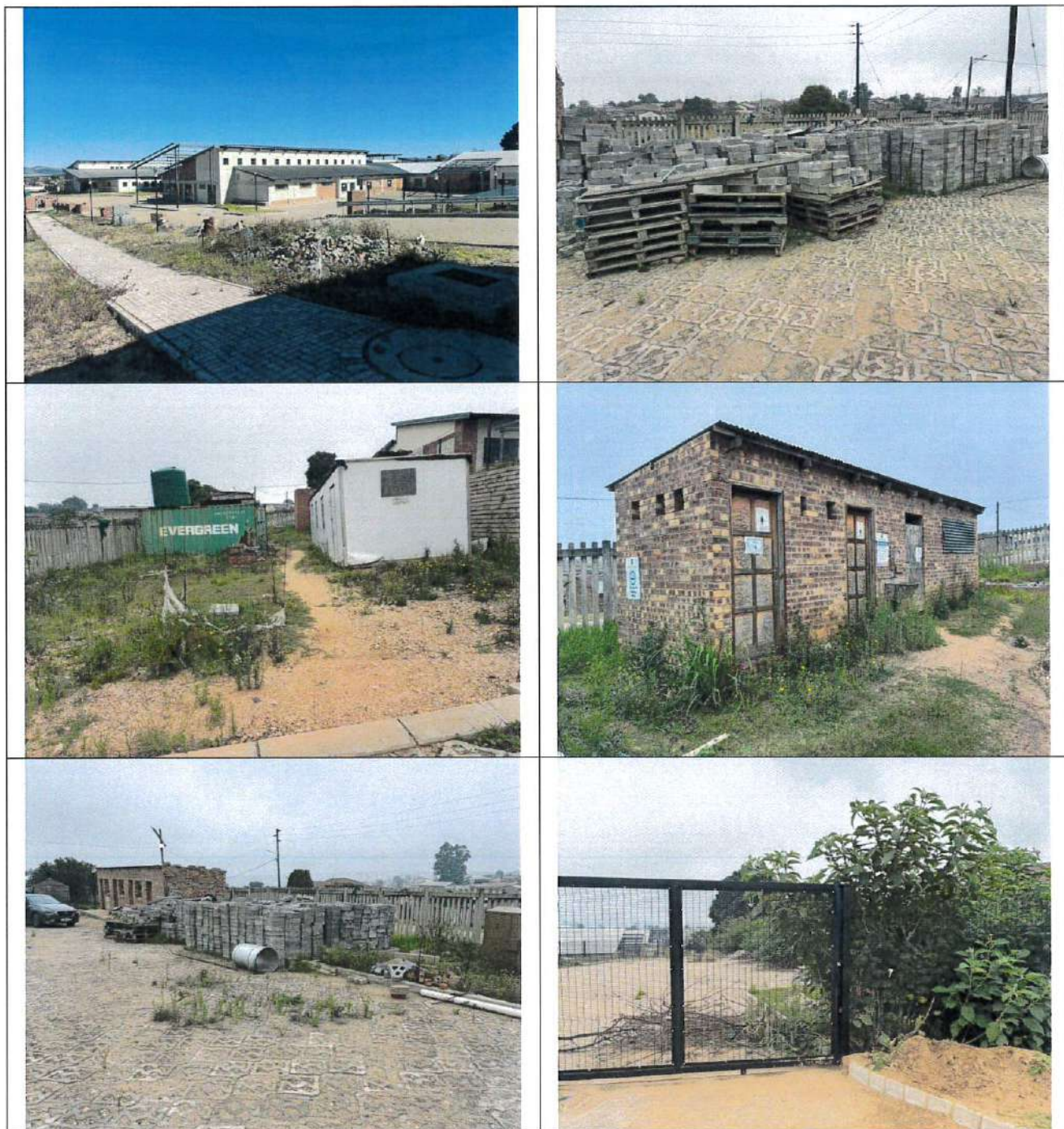
